QUALIFICATIONS

The senior high school student must:

- preferably belong to the STEM and MARITIME strands (Academic Track) for those applying for the **EDAQ Scholarship Grants**;
- preferably belong to the ABM, HUMSS and GAS strands (Academic Track) for those applying for the **DTUQ Scholarship Grants**;
- possess a General Average of at least 85% in Grade 12 3rd Quarter Grades with no grade in any subject below 83%;
- not have taken any course in college prior to the examination.

BENEFITS AND ALLOWANCES

The scholars shall be entitled to the following benefits and allowances:

- no fees throughout the duration of the grantee's program of study*
- semestral stipend of P15,000 which can go up to as high as P25,000 for exceptional academic performance*

T.I.P. does not charge any application fee or examination fee for these scholarship programs.


