Herewith are the other details:

**THEME** : GSP – Bringing Positive Change

**ATTENDANCE** : JUNIORS – At least Forty (40) Girls and Ten (10)  
Troop Leaders per District  
SENIORS and CADETS – At least Eight (8) Girls and  
Two (2) Troop Leaders per School

### QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Must be duly registered Juniors, Seniors, Cadets, Troop Leaders
2. Girls must have Parent's Consent.
3. Girls must have earned at least 2 badges.
4. Girls and Troop Leaders must be physically well to live in the out-of-doors.
5. A Physician's Certificate must be secured by all campers.

**ARRIVAL** : Beginning 2:00 p.m. of March 1  
Early arrivals is discouraged to allow camp staff to prepare the site.

**EVENT'S FEE** : P500.00 per Girl and P300.00 per Troop Leader  
Which covers event's t-shirt, camp kit w/ souvenirs program materials, badges.

*This being an official business for girl-learners and Teachers local funds and other sources of funds like MOOES can be used subject to the standard auditing and accounting procedures.*

**THINGS to BRING :**

**Individual** : Official GSP / Camping uniform  
black shoes and rubber shoes  
jogging pants and/or jeans, GSP T-Shirts for activities  
jacket and raincoat  
personal stuff for a 4-day outdoor life living  
drinking and eating utensils, small pail and dipper  
light beddings and sleeping bag or bed roll  
sit-upon that are water resistant e.g. old tarpaulin,  
or plastic sack  
extra T-Shirt for printing, insect repellent, working flashlight  
art and writing materials, old newspapers and magazines

**Patrol** : Tent for the Patrol  
Food and drinking water supply for the whole duration  
Charcoal Stove or Super Kalan only are allowed  
Cooking utensils and equipment  
2 sets - patrol basin / dipper / pail (for cooking and  
bathroom use) / Garbage bags  
gadgets - shoe rack , tripod, table, clothesline

Note: No chairs or tables will be allowed.
