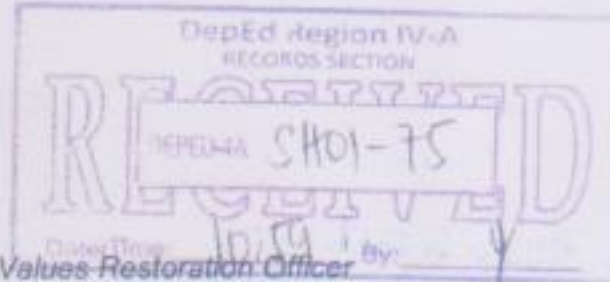

SUBJECT : Values Restoration Program

The Council for the Restoration of Filipino Values (CRFV), a Civil Service Commission Accredited Learning and Development Institution, aims to introduce its Values Restoration Program as a soft approach of the government's anti-corruption initiatives.

In line with this, government agencies are encouraged to support the program by appointing at least two Values Restoration Officers (VRO), from supervisory level and rank and file from their central, regional, provincial, and field offices or units.
