

1. As per DepEd Memorandum No. 131, s.2010 otherwise known as **Continuing Fire Safety and Awareness Program in Schools** in an effort to strengthen the fire safety advocacy in schools, with this year's theme "**Ligtas na Pilipinas ang ating Hangad, Pag-iingat sa Sunog ay sa Sarili Ipatupad**".

Submit after activity report to the division office not later than **March 26, 2018**.
