1. DepEd Region IV-A (CALABARZON), in coordination with the Region IV-A Association of Schools Division Superintendents, Inc., will conduct the 2018 TEA Governance Forum at De La Salle University-Dasmariñas City on 20 February 2018 from 8:30am to 5:00pm with the theme "**Liberating Learners, Empowering Educators through TEA Governance**".
2. The Schools Division Offices shall determine the participants to this forum. Provincial SDOs will send 300 participants while City Schools Division Offices will send 100 participants.
3. A registration fee of one hundred fifty pesos (P150.00) per participant shall be collected to cover administrative expenses. The registration fee and travel expenses of participants shall be charged against local funds, subject to accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Food provisions shall be arranged by the respective Schools Division Offices.
4. Pre-registration of all participants is strongly encouraged. The names of the attendees shall be submitted to the Region IV-A Association of Schools Division Superintendents, Inc. c/o Ms. Ludy M. Pasagui, OIC-SDS Division of Lipa City on or before 17 February 2018. Check payments shall be under the account of the above-stated Association.
5. Schools Divisions are expected to prepare a Tarpaulin and 2-minute video focusing on TEA governance best practices.
