



The Department will provide our schools/SPED centers with regular plantilla SPED Teacher I positions for SY 2018-2019, specifically for those offering non-graded SPED class/es.

To support the request for the creation of the items from the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) and to ensure that there are adequate qualified applicants, all divisions/regions are hereby instructed to submit a list of prospective applicants with corresponding preferred school assignment. Kindly note that the source of the data such as non-graded SPED enrollment and SPED teacher inventory shall be the Beginning of School Year (BOSY) 2017 EBEIS. Attached for your ready reference is the prescribed templates (Annex 1-Regional Template and Annex 2 - Division Template).

In addition, please be advised that prospective applicants shall have meet any of the following qualifications:

- a. Bachelor of Elementary Education specializing in Special Education;
- b. Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education major in Special Education;
- c. Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education plus 18 units in special education in the graduate level with 3 years of teaching experience to children with special needs and with very satisfactory performance in the regular schools for the last 3 years;
- d. Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education plus 15 units in special education with 4 years of teaching experience in children with special needs and with very satisfactory performance in the regular schools for the last 3 years;

- e. Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education plus 12 units in special education with 6 years of teaching experience to children with special needs and with very satisfactory performance in the regular schools for the last 3 years; and
- f. Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education plus 9 units in special education with 9 years of teaching experience to children with special needs and with very satisfactory performance in the regular school for the last 3 years.

The Division Offices shall submit the report using the prescribed template to the Regional Office for final review and consolidation and onward endorsement to the Planning and Programming Division, Planning Service on or before February 9, 2018. To ensure quality of the submission, only regional consolidated report will be considered final and official by said Office. Failure to submit on due date would result the re-allocation of the items to other divisions/regions that have adequately complied and have additional requirements of SPED teachers. To expedite the processing of the report, please send thru electronic mail the signed scanned copy by the Regional Director and the consolidated excel file to ps.ppd@deped.gov.ph.
