

Time Allotment	Three (3) Hours
Description	The ASEAN Quiz is a continuing project of the ASEAN Committee on Culture and Information (COCI) that aims to foster the spirit of healthy competition among ASEAN Youth in a friendly quiz game that exposes them to cultural, political, economic and social information.

Quiz Mechanics

1. The 20 student –participants from DepEd’s 20 divisions shall compete individually in two segments.
2. The two segments are as follows:
 - Segment 1. True or False and Multiple Choice
 - Segment 2. Fill-in-the-Blanks or Completion
3. Segment 1: True or False will be given 10 questions with 1 point each correct answer and Multiple Choice will be given 10 questions and 1 point each correct answer. **Total Score is 20 points**
4. Segment 2: The Fill-in-the-Blanks or Completion will be given 20 questions and every correct answer will be given 3 points. **Total Score is 60 points.**
5. The total points in the competition is 80.
6. The participants shall be seated in individual chairs with armrest.
7. Each participant shall be provided a white board or Paper with marker/pen with eraser to be used in answering the questions for segment one and two.
8. For Segment 1: (True or False and Multiple Choice), participants will write the word True or False for the True or False questions and write the letter of the correct answer for the multiple choice questions. Participants will be given 10 seconds to write down their answer.
9. For Segment 2: (Fill-in-the-Blanks or completion), participants will be given 15 seconds to write down their answers. A buzzer shall indicate that the time is up. Answer shall be written in full; with no abbreviations or acronyms. Articles and prepositions should be written correctly. Answer with wrong spelling will be considered wrong. Corrections may be made by the participants but the previous answer must be erased or crossed out within the given time allotment.

Each question in Segments 1 and 2 will be read twice. After the Quizmaster reads the questions the second time, he/she will say “GO”. Only then will the participants write their answer. When the time is up, the Quizmaster will say “Markers/Pens Up.” Participants will then up their Markers/Pens and whiteboards/Papers to show their answers. The Quizmaster will read aloud the answer of each participant. The scorers will record the answers accordingly. A cumulative score per participant will be announced by the Quizmaster after each round before moving on to the next segment.
10. After the completion of segment 2, the cumulative points of each participant in the two segments will be tabulated. The results will be examined by the RTWG. When the results have

been verified, these will be submitted to the Board of Judges and announced accordingly by the Quizmaster.

11. The Chairman of the Board of Judges shall declare the First, Second and Third place winners. The first place winner will represent the region to the National ASEAN Quiz Competition. The Second/Third Place winners will be the alternate in case the First/Second winner unable to attend the competition.

12. In case of a tie, tiebreaker question/s shall be asked until definite winner emerge. At the start of tiebreaker round, the scores revert to zero. A contestant who got the first three correct answers win.

13. Should there be questions or protests, the Board of Judges shall decide the matter. Their decision is final.

A. CRITERIA FOR THE SELECTION OF PARTICIPANTS

The student-participant for the Regional Level Competition must:

- a. be in grades 9 to 10 between fifteen(15) and seventeen(17) years old; must not be eighteen (18) years old by the time of the REGIONAL Competition (International) which will be held in August 2018 at Indonesia.
- b. come from either a public or a private school;
- c. be proficient in English language both in oral and written;
- d. have a grade of 85 and above in Araling Panlipunan/Social Studies for the first quarter of School Year 2017-2018;
- e. have a good interpersonal skills/be a good team player;
- f. be physically fit;
- g. be willing (parental consent) to travel to Tanza, Cavite for the regional level and as well as for National Level in Quezon City and Regional (International) Competition in Indonesia, if he/she declared first place winner/one of the top three winners.
- h. meet other criteria that may be deemed necessary by the ASEAN Quiz Organizing Committee.

Note:

Relatives up to the second degree of consanguinity of the employees of the implementing and partner agencies of the project shall not be allowed to participate in the National Competition.

B. TEST QUESTIONS

- a. The test questions shall cover the three ASEAN Community Pillars-Political Security, economic and socio-cultural; ASEAN in General; and ASEAN Member States or AMS-specific.
- b. The Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD) DepEd Central Office/Regional Technical Working Group (RTWG), each Social Studies/Araling Panlipunan Education Program

Supervisor in 20 Divisions will prepare 3 questions each category (True or False, Multiple Choice and Fill-in-the-Blanks or Completion)the questions will be sent to leonardo.cargullo@deped.gov.ph on or before March 15, 2018.

c. Suggested material include, among others, official ASEAN publications from the ASEAN Secretariat in Jakarta, Indonesia and the Department of Foreign Affairs Philippines, the ASEAN website (e.g. ASEAN Secretariat, ASEAN Communities, ASEANS Centers, etc.) website of the ASEAN Committee on Culture and Information, websites of all 10 ASEAN Member States and other relevant official websites.
