

SUBJECT : 2018 REGIONAL WOMEN'S MONTH CELEBRATION

DATE : February 27, 2018

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamations No. 224, 227, and Republic Act No. 6949 declaring the first week of March as Women's Week and March 8 as Women's Rights and International Peace Day, and providing for the observance of the month of March as Women's Role in History Month, the Department of Education Region IV-CALABARZON joins the nation in the observance of the 2018 National Women's Month Celebration (NWMC) with the theme: "We Make Change Work for Women" from March 1-31, 2018.
2. In line with the celebration, DepEd CALABARZON, in collaboration with the Regional Gender and Development Committee (RGADC) of the Regional Development Council (RDC), will conduct the regional celebration on March 20, 2018 at Chipeco Hall, Jose Rizal Memorial School, Calamba City.
3. The 2018 celebration aims to:
 - a. inform and engage women as stakeholders of government programs and services to promote citizen-centric governance and make "change" a conscious effort to know, understand, and provide what ALL citizens need;
 - b. create and facilitate platforms to discuss good practices, gaps, challenges, and commitments in pursuing gender and development (GAD) – to strengthen implementation of the Magna Carta of Women; and
 - c. inspire and empower women and girls to be agents of change – to contribute in promoting gender equality and the empowerment of all women.
4. Participants to the celebration are the Regional Line Agencies, state colleges and universities, local government units. Likewise, all SDOs are highly encouraged to send participants to join the celebration on the mentioned date and venue. Provincial SDOs are requested to send ten (10) members of the GAD FPS and five (5) GFPS from the city SDOs

5. It is also encouraged that SDOs shall locally organize their own activities and other initiatives that contribute in the attainment of the mentioned objectives and submit a two-paged Narrative Report with no more than five action photos on or before April 6, 2018 via email @ hrd.calabarzon@deped.gov.ph
6. It is also requested that SDOs to send one (1) pupil-participant from the elementary and (1) one student-participant from the Junior High School to join the Poster Making Contest on March 20, 2018 at the said venue. The participants will be provided with contest materials.
7. Program of activities will be released in a separate Memorandum.
8. Expenses relative to the conduct of the celebration such as meals of the guests, invited regional line agencies, state universities and colleges and local government units, stage décor, supplies and materials, prizes for the poster making contest winners and honorarium of the resource persons shall be charged against the Regional GAD Fund/local funds; while transportation and food of other DepEd participants relative to their participation shall be charged against the local funds/GAD fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedure.
