The Philippine Private School Health Officers' Association (PSHOA), Incorporated, now officially accredited as a CPD Provider and considered the premier organization of private school physician dentists, nurses and allied professionals all over the country, is delighted to announce its **30th Anniversary, 37th Annual Convention and Election of New Board of Directors** on April 26-27, 2018, Thursday-Friday, at the Novotel Manila Araneta Center, Gen. Aguinaldo Ave. in Cubao, Quezon City. This national assembly will carry the theme: **"PSHOA W.I.N.S. (Works to Improve Needed Skill in School Health!)"**
