
The primary objectives of the workshop are:

Participants who will qualify on this training will automatically advance to an In-house Youth Instructors' Training Course (YITC) scheduled on May 9-23, 2018.

REGISTRATION

For areas with more than 10 total applications, the Secretariat Committee will screen the received applications to fill the above target number of participants.

QUALIFICATION REQUIRMENTS:

1. Age ranges from 16 — 25 years old
2. Has undergone and graduated from the Leadership Development Program
3. Photocopy of Leadership Development Program Certificate
4. Letter of Intent
5. Endorsement by the Council Adviser and School Head
6. At least a year member/ volunteer
7. Willing to attend the 15-day Youth Instructors' Training Course on May 9-23, 2018
8. Committed to conduct training within the Rizal Chapter jurisdiction
9. Must be willing to organize Red Cross Youth Councils
10. Willing to document all training conducted
11. Willing to report and render services to the Chapter

For those who will be staying overnight at the venue:
