Specific dates and activities are as follows: (a) Regional Training Workshop on Reading, May 9-11, 2018; (b) CALABARZON Conference on Computer Journalism, May 23-25, 2018.
- The said activities aim to further strengthen and expand not only the skills and competencies of teacher participants but also on reading programs and materials.
