

**TUKLAS (Tungo sa Kahandaan ng Pilipinas) Innovation Labs** is a community-centered innovation project that seeks to discover homegrown solutions on Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM). It is implemented nationwide by a consortium of four non-government organizations (NGOs) with strong presence in over a thousand communities in the Philippines.

Last 2017, The Philippines TUKLAS Innovation Labs has selected its final 40 disaster preparedness innovations, after receiving more than 260 proposals from all 17 regions of the Philippines. The team **reDEAFine** headed by **Mr. Lito A. Palomar**, Chief, CID, **Ms. Nica Regine V. Lico** of Juan Sumulong Elementary School and **Mr. Joseph M. Buena** of Muntindilaw National High School submitted a project proposal on the development of a Disaster Risk Reduction Management Infomercial for the Deaf which aims to educate and empower the Deaf learners on DRRM in an inclusive setting. The said project was approved for funding by TUKLAS.

In lieu with this, a community meeting and orientation with the **TUKLAS (CSL) Team** and **reDEAFine** will be held to selected teachers/school heads involved in the project on Thursday, May 3, 2018 from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm at Juan Sumulong Elementary School. No registration shall be collected from the participants. Meals and other incidental expenses shall be shouldered by TUKLAS Innovation Labs Inc.

Attendance of the teachers/schools heads involved is expected.

Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
