

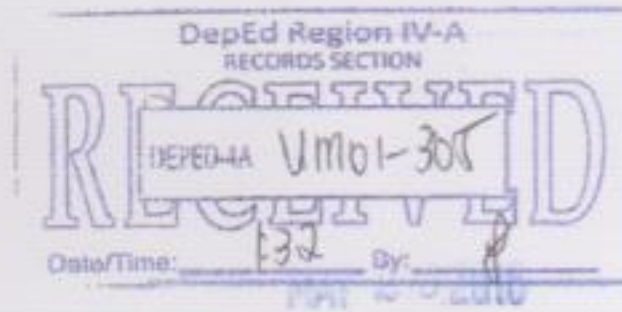

This has reference to the applications of schools from your Region to offer their proposed unique tracks under the Senior High School (SHS) Program in SY 2018-2019.

This Office recognizes the dynamism and responsiveness of the schools to the demand of the society and their direct clientele, the students. The initiative to comply with the set standards and requirements such as recent studies, identification of partners and experts, formulation of MOA/MOU/MOC, determination of resources, and provision of written curriculum are evident with the submitted documents.

However, based on the thorough evaluation of such documents and the deliberation conducted by this Office for all unique track applications, we regret to inform that these schools failed to consider the following in targeting the minimum standards and requirements:

- The consideration of horizontal and vertical articulation of the eight (8) specializations for every unique track within the elementary, junior high, and SHS curricula, TESDA courses, and CHED courses;
- Clear connection to the SHS exits, i.e., Employment, Entrepreneurship, Middle Skills Development and Higher Education;
- The advantage of being affiliated or partnering with national organizations or government institutions;
- Pertinent documents of qualified teachers for the proposed specialization subjects; and
- Availability of SHS-compliant textbooks and other references.

In this regard, we regret to inform you that the schools listed on the next pages (Attachment A) are **disapproved** to offer their proposed unique tracks next school year.
