



**CALL FOR PAPERS OF COMPLETED RESEARCHES AND BEST PRACTICES  
International Assembly of Youth for UNESCO 2018**

*"Protecting Heritage, Fostering Creativity in an Environment of Peace and Justice"*

The following notes are intended to provide guidelines on how to submit the entry for paper presentation for the Y4U2018 on September on 6-8, 2018

1. All papers for the 2018 International Assembly of Youth for UNESCO (Y4U2018) must be submitted **on or before May 15** electronically to the official email address of Y4U [youth4unesco2018@gmail.com](mailto:youth4unesco2018@gmail.com) with the subject PAPER PRESENTATION\_Author's Name (Example: PAPER PRESENTATION\_Hipolito)
2. Papers must showcase the **BEST PRACTICES** of the organization, or may be an output of a **COMPLETED RESEARCH** and must be aligned to any of the following themes:
  - a. Working to end poverty through achieving Zero Hunger in all dimensions
  - b. Ensuring equality of all human beings while fulfilling their potentials in a quality Life Long Learning.
  - c. Protecting the planet while strengthening partnership with others
  - e. Developing Socio-economic and technological progress toward decent production
  - f. Fostering peaceful, just and inclusive societies free from fear and violence
  - g. Restoring and preserving cultural heritages in 21<sup>st</sup> Century
3. Entry must only be submitted once, with no retractions or modifications once received by the organizer. The names of the authors listed on the original submission may not be altered including indication of the lead author's name.
4. In case of multiple authors, **UNDERLINE** the name of the presenter as presented in the sample below:

5. All Paper presenter must email **ONLY THE ABSTRACT** typewritten in 8 ½" X 11" with 1-inch margin in all sides, double spaced, Times New Roman, Font size 12 in MS WORD and PDF formats.
6. The abstract must have a **MAXIMUM** of **250 words only** containing the following:
  - a. short introduction
  - b. methods used
  - c. salient results and discussion
  - d. conclusion and recommendation



- e. for best practices, the outcome and future prospect of the project is a must
- 7. All submitted manuscripts must be original (i.e. not published nor presented elsewhere).
- 8. The organizer will correspond with the lead (primary) author only. It is the primary author's responsibility to notify all co-presenters regarding the status of the entry.
- 9. Upon acceptance of the paper, one or all presenters must register for the full conference registration. All travel and additional expenses, including the conference fee, are the responsibility of the presenter.
- 10. Presenters must wear corporate or business attire during the presentation and must arrive at the venue 15 minutes before the time.
- 11. Presenters will be given 15 minutes to present the paper. Questions will be entertained after all authors have presented.

#### PAPER REVIEW PROCESS

- 1. Submissions are judged on their overall quality (design of the study, development of the concept, etc.), their significance and contribution to the discipline, support to UNESCO ideals and thrusts, and their interest to conference delegates. Innovations on existing programs and projects that will impact conference delegates are most welcome.
- 2. Notification of acceptance will commence on May 30, 2018.

All Paper presenter must email ONLY THE ABSTRACT (maximum 250 words) in 8 1/2 x 11 with 1-inch margin in all sides, double spaced, Times New Roman, Font size 12 in MS WORD and PDF format.

The abstract must have a SUMMARY of 200 words only containing the following:

- a. short introduction
- b. methods used
- c. select results and discussion
- d. conclusion and recommendation

# POSTER MAKING

## GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS

1. The Poster Making Contest is open to all UNESCO ACCREDITED CLUB members; one representative per club or organization only.

2. All interested applicants must submit a pre-registration form which is available at the UNESCO page.

3. The poster must illustrate, interpret and emphasize the theme of the UNESCO y4u 2018.

*"Protecting Heritage, Fostering Creativity in an Environment of Peace and Justice."*

4. The size of the poster should be ¼ illustration board.

5. All needed materials must be provided by the participants during the contest day such as: ¼ illustration board (white background), scratch paper, pen, marker, pencil, oil paints, water color, crayons, coloring pens, oil pastel/craypas, acrylic and others

6. Each participant should submit ONE entry only.

6. All artworks must be done on the spot and must be completed within the allotted time of two (2) hours.

7. All entries must be pre-numbered. No other identifying marks will be allowed to appear in the artworks.

8. The posters will be judged according to the following criteria:

Relevance to the theme (40%)

Creativity and presentation (40%)

Originality (20%)

9. The artist will be held accountable to any issues that may arise with regards to the originality and authenticity of the design.

# ESSAY WRITING

## GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS

### A. Mechanics

1. Essay Writing Competition is open to all UNESCO ACCREDITED CLUB members; one representative per club or organization only.
2. All interested applicants must submit a pre-registration form which is available at the UNESCO page.
3. Participants will be categorized and judged according to level (High School and College)
4. A question related to the theme shall be asked to serve as the main topic which the participants shall write about. The question shall be given during the contest proper; the essay must elaborate, interpret and emphasize the theme of the UNESCO y4u 2018.

5. All entries must be written in English and must have at least 500 words and must not exceed 2000 words.
6. All essays must be done on the spot and must be completed within the allotted time of 1 hour and thirty minutes.
7. All entries will be judged based on content, originality, structure and style.

All entries shall be judged based the following criteria:

Relevance to the theme	45%
Originality	25%
Structure	15%
Style	15%
