





2nd QUARTER NATIONWIDE SIMULTANEOUS EARTHQUAKE DRILL (NSED)

13. The drill participants bring first aid kit or any item noticeable during the evacuation phase.			
14. The drill participants conducted the headcount during the headcount phase.			
15. The evacuation area is big enough to accommodate the evacuees.			
16. The drill participants vacate the building and observed the time to reach the designated evacuation area.			
17. The drill participants stay in the evacuation area without instruction.			
18. The drill participants move to another place without instruction.			
19. The drill participants went back to the building without instruction.

The objectives of the drill/exercise are as follows:


1. To test the efficiency and usefulness of the preparedness, response and recovery plans, systems and policies developed in their respective localities/offices/schools;

4. To understand the command and control mechanism in emergency and disaster operation at the DRRMCs.
