





1. In preparation for the 2nd National Competition for Storybooks Writing of the Department of Education, the City Schools Division of Antipolo, through the Learning Resource Management and Development Section (LRMDS) announces the **2018 Division Storybooks Writing Contest for Kindergarten to Grade 6**.
2. The Contest aims to:
 - a. produce and collect the best storybooks for Kindergarten to Grade 6 aligned with the k to 12 Curriculum; and
 - b. recognize the talents and creativity of the teachers on developing storybooks which are aligned to the needs of learners.
3. This Division Contest is open to all public school Kindergarten to Grade 6 teachers of public elementary schools.
4. Any entry found to be copied or plagiarized shall be disqualified.
5. The decision of the Panel of Evaluators is final and irrevocable.
6. The Guidelines of the contest are adopted from last year National Competition set by the Bureau of Learning Resource (Enclosure No.1) and the Official Entry Form (Enclosure No. 2).
7. All interested teachers must submit their original stories and/or storybook in Mother Tongue on or before August 3, 2018 at the Division LRMD Section, attention to: Mrs. Priscilla V. Salo, Educ. Program Supervisor I.

GUIDELINES FOR THE 2018 DIVISION STORYBOOK WRITING CONTEST FOR KINDERGARTEN TO GRADE 6 TEACHERS

I. General Guidelines

1. The contest is open to all Kindergarten, Grades 1 to 6 teachers of the City Schools Division of Antipolo.
2. Stories and illustrations must be original and unpublished, (not yet submitted to the LRMDs) and free from any copyright infringement.
3. The contest will be in print format.
4. Each school may submit their entry/entries per grade level without limit.
5. Entries must be based on the Kindergarten to Grade 6 learning competencies in the K to 12 Curriculum.
6. The stories to be submitted should be age appropriate for ages 5 to 12 years old.
7. Entries will be submitted in printed copy with a CD containing MS Word and PDF format.
8. Submission of entries must be accompanied by duly accomplished Entry Form.
9. All entries endorsed by the School Head must be submitted to the LRMD Section at the Division Office (Old Bldg).
10. Winning entries per Grade level category will be the Division Entry at the Regional Level.
11. Deadline for submission of entries is on July 6, 2018.

II. Specification Requirements

1. Entries must be written in Filipino.
2. The story should address one or more learning competencies in any learning area from K to 6.
3. The text should be appropriate to the reading and vocabulary level of the learners.
4. The illustrations and photographs should complement the text.
5. The storybook should adhere to the DepEd Social Content Guidelines.
6. The story should showcase experiences, culture, and context that stimulate critical thinking, and promote moral values.
7. The title of the book should not be too long and should be easy to understand.

III. Mechanics of the Contest

A. Submission of Entries

1. Participants will submit two (2) printed and digital copies of entries.
2. Entries should be accompanied with the Official Entry Form.
3. Entries duly certified by the School Principal shall be submitted to the Schools Division Superintendent (SDS) through the Learning Resource Management Development Section.
4. The SDS shall issue a certificate of participation to all participating entries.

B. Evaluation of Entries

1. The Division Screening Committee shall evaluate and select the top three (3) entries per grade level to be submitted to the Regional Office following the criteria set.
2. The winning entry shall be forwarded to the Regional Office together with the results of the Division screening activity.
3. Entries that are not selected at the division level shall be subjected to further quality assurance for possible uploading in the LR Portal.

C. Awarding of Winners

1. The Division will conduct an awarding ceremony to all who participated in the contest.
2. All participating Kindergarten, Grades 1 to 6 Teachers whose entries were selected for evaluation



IV. Criteria for Judging

The following criteria are the bases for judging.
