- Relative to Executive Order No. 29 s.2017 which mandates all national government agencies to observe National Resilience Month for the whole of July of every year, this office would like to enjoin all Schools to participate in this nationwide campaign of building disaster resilience at all levels with this year's theme: "KATATAGAN SA KALAMIDAD ay Makakamtan Kapag Sapat ang Kaalaman sa Kahandaan".
- As part of the celebration, schools are expected to undertake relevant activities which emphasize Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) education such as, but not limited to the following:
 - a. Posting of National Disaster Resilience Month tarpaulin;
 - b. Presence of Standardized School DRRM Team tarpaulin;
 - c. Intensive implementation of Standardized School DRRM Team;
 - Devoting time for class discussion on preparedness, mitigation and prevention during rainy season;
 - e. Conduct of Symposium or Forum on DRRM;
 - Conduct of related activities to ensure heightened awareness, consciousness and mitigation among school administrators, teachers, personnel and school children.
- Further, all schools shall conduct the school watching and hazard mapping as stipulated in Deped Memorandum No. 101, s. 2016 entitled Reminding All Schools to Conduct Student-Led School Watching and Hazard Mapping.
