

Greetings of Peace!

The DIOCESE OF ANTIPOLO is the local unit of the Roman Catholic Church with jurisdiction comprising the province of Rizal, Antipolo City and Marikina City. It is headed by Bishop Francisco M. de Leon. The Diocese of Antipolo Commission on Migrants and Itinerant People (DACMI) is the service arm of the diocese that is concerned with giving pastoral care for migrants and itinerant people especially the OFWs.

May I respectfully inform you that last August 11, 2017 a meeting to activate **SONS AND DAUGHTERS OF OFW FORMATION (SDOFP)** program of our diocese was held at Our Lady of Peace School (OLPS) at Antipolo City. This was participated in by teachers, guidance counselors, principal and student program coordinators coming from both the private and public elementary and high school.

The SDOFP is one of the programs implemented by DACMI in order to provide pastoral care to the children of our migrants, particularly OFWs, in our diocese. This is to address in some ways the negative issues/problems concerning the families of our OFWs. Some of the activities are various issues formation seminars for our students and their families.

In order to institutionalize the SDOFP program, there is a need to set up an organization of guidance counselors and teachers to take care of the continuing program for the children of OFWs. The Anak OFW Congress, Migration Quiz Bee and TOSDOSAs (Ten Outstanding Sons and Daughters of OFW Achievement Award) being incorporated in the program of the school.

We are very much in need of your support as public school teachers can not attend any activity if they do not have travel order from your office.

As a concrete support, please allow your high school teachers who have attended the Seminar and those who are still interested to attend a general meeting on 28 August 1-5 p.m. at Antipolo National High School and the next meetings that will be scheduled by the group.
