





SUBJECT : **Career Guidance for Grade 12 Students**

DATE : September 25, 2018

In consonance with the Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2012 that states that, "To properly guide the students in choosing the career tracks that they intend to pursue, the DepEd, in coordination with the DOLE, the TESDA and the CHED, shall regularly conduct career advocacy activities for secondary level students."

As such, this Office in partnership with the City Government of Antipolo, edukasyon.ph, DOLE Rizal, TESDA, Rizal and GPTA Antipolo will conduct a CAREER GUIDANCE FOR GRADE 12 STUDENTS on OCTOBER 16, 17 and 18 at Sports Hub, Antipolo. All Grade 12 Students are requested to attend the activity on the scheduled date indicated below.

The event has exhibitors with partner industries and prospective employers. Students are requested to bring their resumes for possible employment.

To ensure the smooth conduct of this activity, Career Guidance Program (CGP) Coordinators of each school shall take charge of the coordination with their respective principals, class advisers, parents and other persons involve. Likewise, CGPs must be with the G12 students together with some advisers on the schedule assigned. Travel arrangement of schools that are far from the venue may be coordinated with the barangay officials as suggested by the City Government Scholarship Office. Schools may devise their own plan of action with regards to the class schedule, teacher participants and other concerns.



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Private schools are also invited to join the activity. Coordination may be made through the SGOD Office (Dr. Isabel M. Gonzales or Ms. Gayle J. Malibiran).
