# 19th NATIONAL CONVENTION AND SEMINAR-WORKSHOP OF THE NATIONAL ORGANIZATION OF PROFESSIONAL TEACHERS INC.

- 1. The National Organization of Professional Teachers Inc. (NOPTI) will conduct the 19th National Convention and Seminar-Workshop with the theme NOPTlans: Sustaining a Strong Community of Learners and Stakeholders' Partnership and Living a Culture of Excellence Towards an Enhanced K to 12 Program Implementation from November 23 to 25, 2018 at the Baguio Teachers Camp, Baguio City.
- 2. The convention aims to:
  - a. provide the participants with important updates on the enhanced K to 12 program;
