Please refer to the List and Schedule of Interactive Poster Presenter that will be posted in the venue.

Lead Facilitators will collaborate with the CBER-SEA Secretariat regarding the List of Interactive Poster Presenters. In addition, they will brief the participants what will transpire in the period of one (1) hour.

Group Moderators in each session will facilitate one hundred sixty-four (164) presenters per session but there will only be 8-10 presenters in each group and will be given time to talk about their research simultaneously for 3-5 minutes with their fellow participants. The remaining time will be given for participants to interact, talk, and ask questions amongst their groupmates about the research in their group. Moreover, they will manage the time wisely so as not to delay the start-up of the next session.
