SUBJECT : CLINIQUING OF 2019 NSPC QUALIFIERS- INDIVIDUAL AND GROUP CONTESTS (PHASE 1)

DATE : November 20, 2018



1. The Department of Education Region IV-A CALABARZON, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), announces the conduct of the **Cliniquing of 2019 NSPC Qualifiers – Individual and Group Contest Categories (Phase 1)** on December 10-14, 2017, 8AM to 6PM daily at Tagaytay City Science National High School to be hosted and facilitated by the champion SDO, Cavite Province.
2. The 2018 NSPC Qualifiers are the top 3 individual winners and the select individuals to compose the team for group contest as stipulated in Regional Memorandum No. 716, s. 2018, entitled 2019 NSPC (SY 2018-2019) Results. The 2019 NSPC Qualifiers must be joined in by their official School Paper Advisers (SPAs) and Education Program Supervisors (EPSs) only. The participants are obliged to attend and participate actively in all of the required sessions within and/or outside the Cliniquing venues. They are also expected to bring and provide themselves with the necessary materials and equipment required for their respective contest categories. Other winners among the top 7 in the individual categories are also encouraged to attend.
3. There shall be NO REGISTRATION FEE. Participants shall take care of their own transportation, food, accommodation and other incidental expenses which may be charged to MOOE, provincial local funds or the city's special education fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

4. All EPSs in-charge of Journalism per SDO are obliged to attend and assist in the conduct of the Cliniquing. EPSs with their respective school paper advisers (SPAs) qualifiers must be responsible not only for the food, accommodation and transportation their 2019 NSPC Qualifiers but also for their safety and security all throughout the conduct of the Cliniquing. Thus, the parents' permit, waiver and medical certificates must be secured by each SDO for clearance and security purposes.
5. Food of the Regional Technical Working Group and facilitators, honoraria of the trainers/field experts, supplies and other related expenses shall be charged to the Regional Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Meanwhile, the host SDO shall take charge of the Cliniquing venues and accommodation for the trainers, facilitators and the regional technical working group which may be charged to MOOE, provincial local funds or the city's special education fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. They must also take charge of the registration, program, exercise/team building, documentation and coordination with the possible target venues for photoshoot and sports writing activities.
7. This office expects full implementation of Regional Memorandum No. 13, s. 2015, entitled "Special Consideration to Learners' Active Participation and Exemplary Performance to Co-Curricular Activities." Likewise, the Office expects the school paper adviser and the EPSs to submit reports documenting the 2019 NSPC Qualifiers' status/progress/readiness during and even after the Phase 1 Cliniquing to be submitted and reported on the Phase 2 Cliniquing of 2019 NSPC Qualifiers.
8. This Office also reminds the field of the submission of School Paper Entries for 2019 NSPC on November 27, 2018 at the Regional Office from 8:00 am to 12:00 nn. **Please refer to the attached guidelines for the submission of School Paper Contests.**
9. Further, the following CASPA Officers are requested to report to the Regional Office on November 27, 2018 to assist in preparing for the school paper entries:
