

1. The Antipolo City Council will conduct its **4th Advancement Camp** at Juan Sumulong Elementary School on January 25-27, 2019.
2. Objectives:
 - A. To support DepEd Order No. 76, s. 2012 entitled "Guidelines on Revitalizing Boy Scouting in Schools Nationwide", particularly paragraph 3.5 which states that "all DepEd officials, personnel, school children and youth are enjoined to participate in scouting activities such as Jamborees, Camps, Competitions, Trainings and Conferences in the School, Division, Regional and International Levels, subject to existing DepEd policies rules and regulations."
 - B. To expose students and adult leaders on environmental awareness and preservation, promotion of leadership skills enhancement and advancement.
3. An activity fee of Three Hundred Pesos (Php 350.00) shall be charged from each participant to cover costs of program materials, administrative needs, awards, souvenir items and other miscellaneous expenses. Expenses (Registration, Transportation expenses and miscellaneous expenses) relative thereto can be charged to School funds/Sponsors subject to usual accounting and auditing procedures.
4. A non – refundable deposit of One Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php 150.00) must be paid to the Antipolo City Council on or before January 18, 2019 to ensure acceptance of application, together with the official list of participants. The remaining balance of Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php 200.00) must be paid upon the arrival at the venue.
5. Participants:

Participants to this activity are KAD, Boy, Senior and Rover Scouts, Kawan & Troop Leaders, Outfit Advisors, Institutional Scouting Representatives (Private & Public), District Scouting Coordinators.
6. Qualification: Every participant is expected to satisfactorily meet the following requirements:
 - Duly registered
 - One set Type "A" uniform
 - Medical Certificate and Parents Permit
 - Food Provisions for three days
 - ruler, scissors, pencil, ball-pen, notebook, pentel pen, bond papers
 - 6 ft. rope, ½ diameter and Flashlight / camera (optional)
 - Working clothes
 - Extra Personal Need
 - Sleeping Gears
 - Eating Utensils
7. All Elementary and Secondary School Principals, School Scouting Coordinators (Public and Private) are advised to have a well-coordinated preparation to ensure the greatest majority of the scouts are given maximum opportunity to participate in this event.
8. All participants are expected to be at the venue on or before 6:00 PM of January 25, 2017.

9. There will be a meeting of all BSP District and School Scouting Coordinators (KAWAN, TROOP LEADERS, OUTFIT ADVISORS and Circle Managers) at Juan Sumulong Elementary School on January 16, 2019 (Wed) at exactly 3 PM.
