NATIONAL ARTS MONTH 2019 – Painting Competition

Mechanics & Guidelines:

1. The competition is open to all Antipolo residents for Category A & B.
Category A - Grades 5 - 8
Category B - Grades 9 - 12
Category C - 18 years old and above open to Rizal artist.
Category D - All female on the spot painting contest c/o Soroptimist International
to be held at Robinsons Place, Antipolo City – mechanics on separate sheet.
2. Entries for Categories A & B must be endorsed by the participating school/s as their official representative stating their grade level. All entries should have their Title.
3. Size of the canvass: Category A & B = 18 x 24" Canvass will be supplied by the organizers
Category C = 18 x 18" Casvass will be supplied by the organizers
4. Each participant will use their own art materials and may use either oil or acrylic paint
5. Interested parties may submit their pre-qualifying sketch in OSLO paper landscape orientation
6. With the theme "Mesmerizing Antipolo" the competition should focus on the following
 - a. Category A – Tourist destinations in Antipolo
 - b. Category B – Events in Antipolo
 - c. Category C – "Rizal" : Portrait of a Hero
7. Last day for submission of pre-qualifying sketch will be on February 8, 2019, 5:00 PM at the Tourism office 2nd floor GAD Center Bldg. Carigma St. Brgy. San Roque, Antipolo City
8. Top 10 entries / category will be selected and will submit their art-piece on or before February 15, 2019. All entries must be signed by the artist, Final judging will be on February 18, 2019
9. Exhibit and Awarding ceremonies will be on February 21, 2019 at the Mall Atrium, Robinsons Place, 2:00 pm.
10. Winners will receive the following :

I. RATIONALE

The art contest is part of the LYD campaign launched by SI Antipolo to celebrate the power and accomplishment of women, to inspire them to live their dreams and realize their full potential. The art contest also aims to showcase the vast and rich artworks of young, talented and budding homegrown female artists from schools in Antipolo and the entire province of Rizal, arguably the country's art capital.

II. MECHANICS

1. Participants are limited to female pupils/students, ages 4-18, and duly certified bonafide students of public or private schools in Antipolo.
2. The artworks will be judged in the following categories:
 - Category 1: Ages 4-7
 - Category 2: Ages 8-11
 - Category 3: Ages 12-15
 - Category 4: Ages 16-18
3. Participants in Category 1 and Category 2 must draw/paint a woman who serves as a mentor or role model in their lives and share how this woman inspires or motivates them. This woman could be someone from history or someone in the participant's personal life.
4. Participants in Category 3 and Category 4 must draw/paint a 'Mother and Child' or 'Woman and Child'.
5. The drawings can be created in any medium: pencil, oil paint, crayon or watercolor to be provided by the participant.
6. Artwork should be done on size 11" x 14" sketch pad/ art board provided by the participant.
7. All artworks must be original.
8. An entry form provided by SI Antipolo on the contest day must be completed by each participant (with the help of her teacher or guardian) and must be attached at the back of her artwork prior to submission. Artwork that does not have an attached entry form will be disqualified.
9. A competent Board of Judges shall be formed by SI Antipolo. The Criteria for Judging shall be formulated by SI Antipolo and the Board. Such criteria shall be made known to the participants on the contest day.
10. Cash prizes, medals and trophies shall be awarded to the winners in each category.
11. All winning artworks become the property of SI Antipolo.
12. SI Antipolo reserves the right to use the winning artworks on its website and in other purposes the club so deems.
