This is to announce the administration of the entrance test to screen the Grade 7 applicants to the Science, Technology and Engineering (STE) Program SY. 2019-2020 on Saturday, March 9, 2019 at San Jose National High School, Sen. L. Sumulong Memorial Circle, Pulong Banal, Brgy. San Jose, Antipolo City at exactly 8 o'clock in the morning.
2. To qualify, the applicants must be:
 - A grade 6 pupil who is candidate for graduation from either public or private school in Antipolo City.
 - Has the grade indicated below in the following learning areas:


Science	-	not lower than 85%
Mathematics	-	not lower than 85%
English	-	not lower than 83%
Other Subjects	-	not lower than 80%
 - Bring Xerox copy of F138 duly signed by the adviser and school head.
 - Certification from the School Head that he/she belongs to the top 30% of the graduating class.
 - Certificate of Good Moral.
3. Applicants who qualify the admission test and interview should undergo physical/medical examination from any public physician, results of which should be submitted upon enrolment together with the PSA (NSO) birth certificate.



- The School Selection Committee shall be headed by the Principal of San Jose National High School and selected teachers shall serve as members who will administer, check the test and conduct interview. Result of which shall be submitted to this office:
