





TO : All Council Scouts Executives of all Ranks

SUBJECT: **8TH ONE SOUTHERN LUZON REGIONAL SCOUTS JAMBOREE**

1. In consonance with the approved National Calendar of Scouting Events and Observances, the Southern Luzon Region, BSP, is pleased to announce the conduct of the **8TH One Southern Luzon Regional Scouts Jamboree** to be hosted by the Antipolo City and Rizal Councils to be held on **01 - 05 March 2019**.
2. The Jamboree aims to provide a progressive, safe and enjoyable learning environment for the Scouts in order to enhance their physical, social, mental, emotional and spiritual potentials. At the end of the Jamboree, the participants should be able to:
 - a. Promote the highest quality of Scouting, one that is faithful to the mission, principles and method of Scouting and adapted to the needs and aspirations of young people;
 - b. Undertake activities related to the current thrusts of the World Scouting (Environment Education, Peace Education and Development Education) through the Messengers of Peace (MoP) Initiatives, World Scout Environment Programme (WSEP, including the Solar Badge) and the Scouts of the World Award (SWA);
 - c. Undergo projects, programs and activities that will cater to the fulfillment of the requirements of selected merit badges and Scout ranks under the Advancement Scheme;
 - d. Develop core life skills and 21st century leadership capabilities through team building, cooperative learning, group dynamics, creative problem-solving and decision-making skills;
 - e. Keep oneself abreast with the prevailing issues about the environment, human rights, health, education; and
 - f. Strengthen the camaraderie among brother Scouts.

3. Requirements for Participation:

SCOUTS	UNIT LEADERS
- Registered Boy/Senior/Rover Scouts	- Registered Unit/Asst. Unit Leader
- physically & mentally fit as certified by a government physician	- physically & mentally fit as certified by a government physician
- with at least 1 year camping experience	- with at least 1 year camping experience
- with parental consent and permit	- with institutional permit
- of good moral character	- of good moral character

4. An Activity Fee of Seven Hundred pesos (PhP700.00) shall be charged each Scout and Adult participant to cover costs of souvenir items, certificate, program and administrative needs. A Reservation Fee of Four Hundred pesos (PhP 400.00) together with the roster of participants on or before **31 January 2019**.

5. What to Bring:

- Tentage for shelter	- Food Supply for the duration of the event
- Two sets of Type "A" Scout's uniform	- Cooking and eating utensils
- light camping materials/equipment	- Enough work & play clothes daily wear, etc.
- maintenance medicines	- camping gears/ground cloth
- camera, toiletries, musical instruments and other personal needs and necessities	

6. All Contingents are expected to take care of their transportation to and from the venue, equipment/supplies and enough food provisions for the duration of the event. Expenses which may be incurred relative to this annual regional Scout event can be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures and regulations.


7. All concerned are expected to exert extra coordinated efforts to ensure maximum participation of all qualified Scouts and Adult Leaders.
