**DATE :** January 30, 2019

Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 43, s. 2011, Strengthening the School Health and Nutrition Programs for the Achievement of the Education for All (EFA) and Millennium Developmental Goals (MDGs), one of the Health and Nutrition Programs that address EFA Goals (Expanding early childhood care and education; Improving the quality of education; and Providing learning and life skills to young people and adults) and MDG Goals (Eradicate extreme poverty and hunger; Reduce child mortality rate; Combat HIV/AIDS, malaria and other diseases; and Ensure environmental sustainability) is to conduct Nutritional Assessment (Baseling, Midline and Endline).

In connection to this, please be reminded that the **ENDLINE NUTRITIONAL ASSESSMENT** of ALL LEARNERS (Kinder to Grade 12) should be done on **February 4 – 8, 2019**. All reports should be duly signed by the School Head and shall be submitted at [jed.david@deped.gov.ph](mailto:jed.david@deped.gov.ph). All **SECONDARY SCHOOLS** should also submit their consolidated **BASELINE** Nutritional Assessment. Deadline for submission of Consolidated Endline Nutritional Status is until **FEBRUARY 22, 2019** only.

Schools are advised to coordinate with the Barangay Health Workers and other possible partners/stakeholders for the smooth conduct of the activity. Health and Nutrition personnel will also monitor the conduct of nutritional assessment.
