

1. Pursuant to Proclamation No. 224 s. 1998 declaring the first week of March each year as Women's Week and March 8 as Women's Rights and International Peace Day and Proclamation No. 227 s. 1998 providing for the observance of Month of March as Women's Role in History Month, this office shall conduct Martsa ni Juana: 2019 National Women's Month Forum and Gawad Balangay on March 16, 2019 from 7:30 – 12:00 nn. at Antipolo National High School.
2. The activity aims to:
 - 2.1 Create an avenue for women and women advocates to celebrate the gains in closing gender gap;
 - 2.2 Promote gender equality and women's empowerment; and
 - 2.3 Strengthen public advocacy on National Women's Month, with emphasis on women's issues that still need to be addressed.
3. The forum is open to school principals, teachers and other DepEd personnel who are advocates of women's rights and gender equality.
4. A registration fee of One Hundred Pesos (PhP 100.00) shall be collected from each participant, chargeable against personal funds and strictly on a voluntary basis, to defray operational and incidental expenses of the activity and honorarium of speakers.
5. Other proceeds shall also go to the beneficiaries of the Bless Libis and Sibol Paglitaw project of the Division of Antipolo City.
6. Participants shall be provided with certificates of participation.
7. Wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

2019 GAWAD BALANGAY

Rationale:

In compliance to the Civil Service Commission's Awards and Incentives Mechanism, Magna Carta for Public School Teachers, DepEd's Project PRAISE, Scouters Rock and Ang Tipulo, Araling Panlipunan shall conduct the annual GAWAD BALANGAY SA EDUKASYON to recognize the exemplary performance and outstanding contributions of teachers, educators and academicians in the field of social sciences. *Balanghais* means boat, a vehicle that was believed to be iconic of the early Filipinos who were mainly people of the sea. The *Banghais* is the perfect symbol for teachers who sail through the calm, placid, and dynamic ocean called teaching-learning process.

Mechanics:

1. There will be no district eliminations.
2. All schools (elementary and junior/senior) may nominate one school-based search winner, endorsed by the principal and attested by the PSDS (or endorsed by the PSDS in the case of principal's category), provided that nominee (teacher and school head) have at least reached a cut off score of 50% (without the demonstration teaching)
3. Pertinent Documents should have submitted to the Division Office Attention: LITO A. PALOMAR, OIC Chief / EPS – Araling Panlipunan, on or before March 8, 2019.
4. Interview shall be scheduled on March 11-13, 2019.
5. Awarding ceremonies will take place during the Martsa ni Juana Forum on March 16, 2019
6. Awardees are requested to be in Filipiniana Attire.


