### 1. Qualifications of Participants

#### GIRLS to ADULTS:

- Duly registered Girl Scouts as of January 7, 2019
- Must be physically fit to join outdoor games.

#### GIRLS:

- Must have a duly signed Parent's Consent
- Must have at least participated in any GS activity



## 2. Delegation:

- > Preferably not less than 16 Girls (Twinklers, Stars and Juniors) and 4 Adults per Elementary School
- > Not less than 20 Seniors/Cadets per Secondary School.

## 3. Event's Fee to help finance program materials, badges, certificate

- ↓ Girls - P50.00 each
- ↓ Adults - P20.00 each

These ~~being an official activity you~~ may be charged to your MOOE/Local Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.

## 4. What to wear:

Girls: Official GSP Uniform or official GSP White T-shirt w/ logo in front paired with either GSP Bermuda shorts, jogging pants or denim pants. Please wear official GSP Age Level Scarf and shoes.

Adults: GSP Alternative Uniform, White Blouse w/ green pants or GSP Polo Shirt (white w/ green collar) or GSP T-shirt w/ logo in front paired either w/ GSP Green pants or jogging pants.

## 5. Things to Bring:
