

Pursuant to Presidential Proclamations No. 224, 227, s. 1988 and Republic Act No. 6949 s. 1990 declaring the first week of March as Women's Week and March 8 as Women's Rights and International Peace Day, and providing for the observance of the month of March as Women's Role in History Month, the Department of Education Region IV-CALABARZON joins the nation in the observance of the 2019 National Women's Month Celebration (NWMC) with the theme: "We Make Change Work for Women" from March 1-31, 2019.
2. The 2019 celebration aims to:
  - a. inform and engage women as stakeholders of government programs and services to promote citizen-centric governance and make "change" a conscious effort to know, understand, and provide what ALL citizens need;
  - b. create and facilitate platforms to discuss good practices, gaps, challenges, and commitments in pursuing gender and development (GAD) – to strengthen implementation of the Magna Carta of Women; and
  - c. inspire and empower women and girls to be agents of change – to contribute in promoting gender equality and the empowerment of all women.
3. In line with the celebration, the Regional GAD Committee of the Regional Development Council shall conduct the regional celebration on March 28, 2019 in Batangas Province.
4. As regional line agency member of the RGADC, this Office requests SDOs to participate in the On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest by sending one (1) pupil-participant from the elementary and (1) one student-participant from the Junior High School to join the said contest on March 28, 2019. Please submit names of the official participants to the said contest on or before March 8, 2019 via email @ [hrd.calabarzon@deped.gov.ph](mailto:hrd.calabarzon@deped.gov.ph) The participants will be provided with contest materials. A separate Memorandum shall be released to communicate the exact venue and the contest mechanics.

It is also encouraged that SDOs shall organize their own activities and other initiatives that contribute in the attainment of the mentioned objectives and submit a two-paged Narrative Report with no more than five action photos on or before April 5, 2019 via email @ [hrd.calabarzon@deped.gov.ph](mailto:hrd.calabarzon@deped.gov.ph)
6. Expenses relative to the conduct of the celebration such as prizes for the poster making contest winners and travel expenses of the RO participants to the regional celebration shall be charged against the RO GAD Fund while travel and other expenses of the SDO participants relative to their participation to the RGADC RWMC shall be charged against the local funds/GAD fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedure.
